KAYAK TOUR ON THE RIVER ISLOCH

TYPE: a kayak tour DURATION: 4 days DISTANCE: 65 km TIME AND DATES: Every day in June - August (please contact for times and availability) ROUTE: Village Mezhdurechje – village Padnevichi – village Borovikovshcina - tourist camping Sutoki – village Pribornye – village Belokorets – village Dorogun' – village

Bakshty - the outfall of Isloch river

DESCRIPTION OF THE RIVER AND ROUTE:

Isloch River flows within the Minsk Upland, Then the river passes through the Nalibokski Dense Forest, giving travelers an unforgettable experience from the surrounding nature and clean water.

This is one of the few rivers in Belarus, where the trout can be found. The banks are steep, the river is winding and narrow. To regulate

the flow there were built three dams. During the tour (the 2nd day) you can visit the ruins of the summer palace of the former estate of Count Tyszkiewicz XIX-XX centuries. Distance from Minsk: 30-40 km. The length of the river is 102 km. Places for camping can be found every 15-30 minutes

LEVEL AND REQUIREMENTS:

Medium / suitable for experienced but also can be recommended for beginners as well looking for bright impressions. Swimming skills are essential¹

HOW TO DRESS:

Outdoor clothing incl. a rain jacket and light footwear, sunscreen, swimming suite/ trousers. No cotton clothes (t-shirt, jeans etc.) if possible. Please have an extra set of clothes to change.

NECESSARY EQUIPMENT: a tent, a sleeping pad, a sleeping bag, matches, a flashlight, Cookware Utensils. Also take a Also take a First Aid Kit, food for 4 days and drinking water. Other things are optional.

TECHNICAL TRANSFER: up to 8 kayaks – 0.4 EUR/km.

PASSANGER TRANSFER: independently (or on request)

COST: rent of 1 double kayak, 2 paddles, 2 life vests for 4 days = 85 EUR (incl. St or Sn)/ 50 EUR (Mon-Fri)
